### HRSA Announces Training in Primary Care Medicine and Dentistry Grants

The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) recently announced competitions for the Training in Primary Care Medicine and Dentistry Grant Program. HRSA is making available American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grant funds of approximately \$48 million in combination with an additional funding opportunity of \$54 million in Fiscal Year (FY) 2010 regular appropriations for two-year projects to support the following six program areas: academic administrative units, residency training, predoctoral training, faculty development training, physician assistant training, and general and pediatric dental residency training. The discipline of Family Medicine is eligible to receive ARRA and FY 2010 funds, however, HRSA will not combine ARRA and FY 2010 funds in supporting any single project. No FY 2010 funds are available for the disciplines of General Internal Medicine, General Pediatrics, or Physician Assistant Training; only ARRA funds are available. Special consideration shall be given to projects to prepare practitioners to care for underserved populations and other high risk groups such as the elderly, individuals with HIV/AIDS, substance abusers, homeless, and victims of domestic violence.

**Applications are due March 24, 2010, at 8:00 PM (EDT) via [www.grants.gov](http://www.grants.gov); additional information is due on April 9, 2010, at 5:00 PM (EDT) via HRSA's Electronic Handbooks System.**

Funding provided to meet the costs of planning, developing, or operating programs and for financial assistance to residents in such programs such as general dentistry or pediatric dentistry in dental schools, approved residency programs in the general or pediatric practice of dentistry, approved advanced education programs in the general or pediatric practice of dentistry, or approved residency programs in pediatric dentistry.
