- Second and third place: Dr. Zsolt Nagykaladi and his team of the Oklahoma Physicians Research/Resource Network, for their articles "*Impact of a Wellness Portal on the delivery of patient-centered preventive care*" (second place) and "*The role of health information technology in the translation of research into practice: an Oklahoma Physicians Resource/Research Network (OKPRN) study*" (third place)
